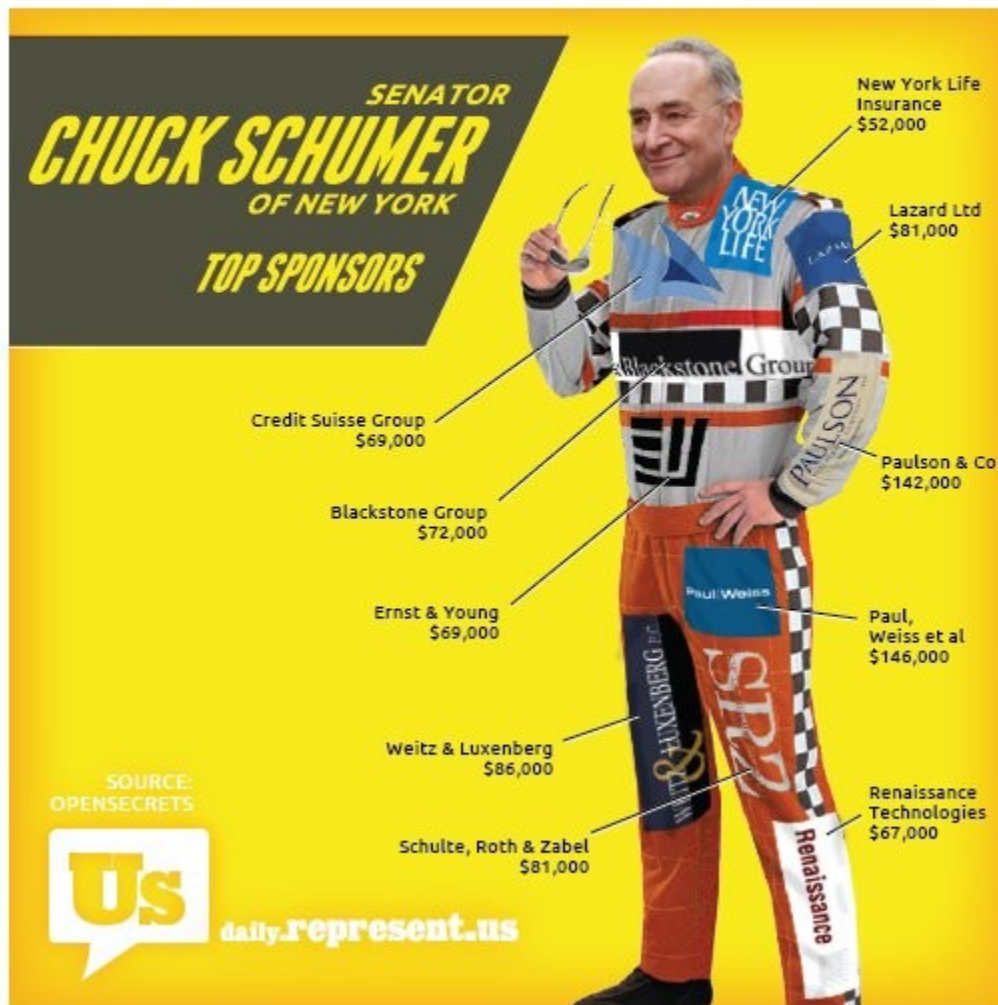


# How U.S. Senator Charles Schumer sold out New York State and the entire United States of America.

Many believe U.S. Senator Charles Schumer, a Brooklyn native no less, sold N.Y. State down the river in a pivotal vote in 2012 that ultimately set the stage for the aircraft noise and pollution problems now plaguing cities across the country.

It's not complicated to understand, although politicians will try to make it sound so.

The FAA 2012 Reauthorization Bill contained specific language that granted the FAA something called a “Categorical Exclusion” - a point of law that allows the FAA to evade environmental studies for any new navigational approaches and departures across the U.S. All New York Democrats across the board – from both Houses (the Senate and House of Representatives) voted Nay on that bill, recognizing that it would cause irreparable harm not only to their constituents in New York state, but also to all American citizens across the country. Senator Charles Schumer was the only Democrat in New York to vote in favor of the legislation that would give the FAA their get out of jail for free card.
